

We hope everyone is having a great summer. Here at Bobby's Run and Lumberton Middle School, we have been working on making our arrival and dismissal procedures safer, particularly in the areas of busses and student drop-off/pickup. We have talked to many parents and worked closely with our School Resource Officer. Through these discussions we have developed a new procedure that we hope will be safer for all involved. We are going to be changing the areas in which cars and busses drop off at LMS. Please read below to see how this will impact you and your student.



**Busses-** All busses will enter the complex property via the LMS entrance and will pull up to the area along the wooden barrier where cars previously lined up. All students who ride busses will then walk the path and sidewalk to their respective schools.

**Student Drop off and Pick Up-** Drop off for BRS will remain the same. All BRS cars will enter the complex, veering left at the fork on Dimsdale and pull up in front of BRS. All LMS cars will enter the complex veering to the right at the fork toward LMS. You will notice cones separating the road into two lines. All cars must stay to the left and follow the route to drop students off. All students must be dropped at the curb. *Cars shall not allow students to exit the vehicles and walk through the parking lot.* Since the cars will now be able to pull all the way up, in the area previously occupied by busses, LMS students can enter the building through the main entrance to LMS or the doors at the end of the 200, 500, or 1300 wings. *Cars shall not pull up the lanes reserved for parking to drop or pick up their students, as this will create an unsafe situation for students.*

**Walkers and Bike Riders-** LMS students may enter the school through the doors at the end of the 200, 500, or 1300 wings. You should park your bike on the rack and enter the school through the door closest to where your bike is parked. All students choosing to ride a bike to school must wear a helmet.

Procedures for BRS walkers will remain the same. All students walking or biking to school are required to use this path. BRS students walking or biking to school are required to enter BRS through the 4th grade hallway entrance at the rear of the building next to the bike rack.

We know this is a different procedure from the past, but we had too many close calls with cars and busses and we want all students to be safe coming to and from school. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
